FIRST READING: Exodus 16:1-15

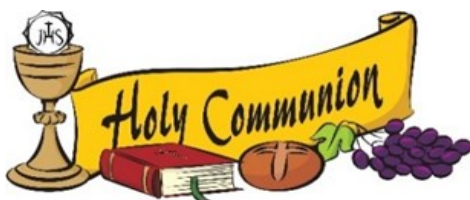
SECOND READING: 2 Corinthians 9:8-11
